## DEPARTMENT SPOTLIGHTS

### 1. Dnnovate - AR VR Lab



The IT Department has carried out an initiative and established an Industry Supported Lab in coalition with Dnnovate Technologies, Bangalore, on 6th March 2020 in the area of AR/VR. SVP CET has made an Investment of 2 Lakhs (Approx.) and Dnnovate is going to procure Training, Internship & Project, Placement to IT students. 36 Students (28 second year & 08 third year) had participated in a 50 hrs workshop on AR/VR in February 2020 and have completed an internship in AR/VR.



### 2. National Level FDP

During the pandemic, the IT department organized 3 Online National Level FDP on “Teaching-Learning Processes using ICT Tools for Education 4.0” to impart knowledge to faculty members of colleges, teachers of school and received an overwhelming response of 6500+ attendees from all over the world. FDP - Part 1 was conducted from 8th to 13th June 2020, with 2722 participants, from 25 states of India and 7 countries from the world. FDP - Part 2 was regulated from 3rd to 5th July 2020, with 2910 participants from 29 states wherein Bani Paintal Dhawan, Head of Education, India, and South Asia, Google Cloud India Pvt Ltd was invited as a speaker for the valedictory program. FDP - Part 3 was the paid event that where department has generated around 1.5 lakhs through online teaching mode that was scheduled from 20th to 25th July 2020, with 548 participants all over India.

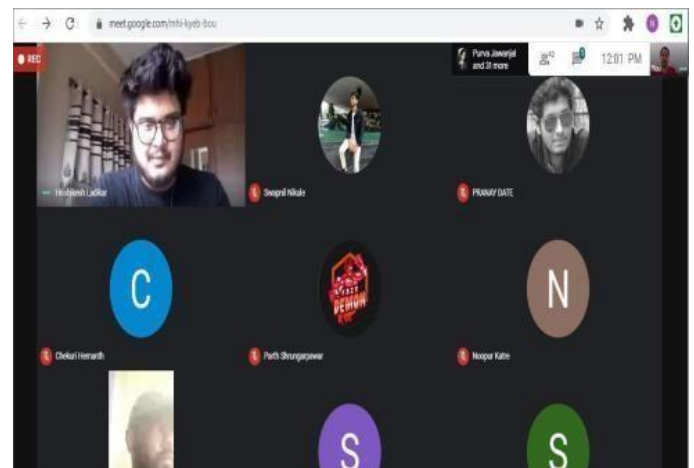
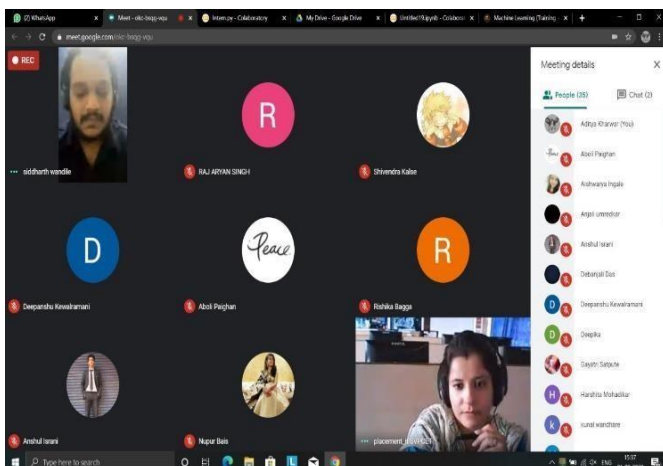
### 1. Alumni Talk on Big Data

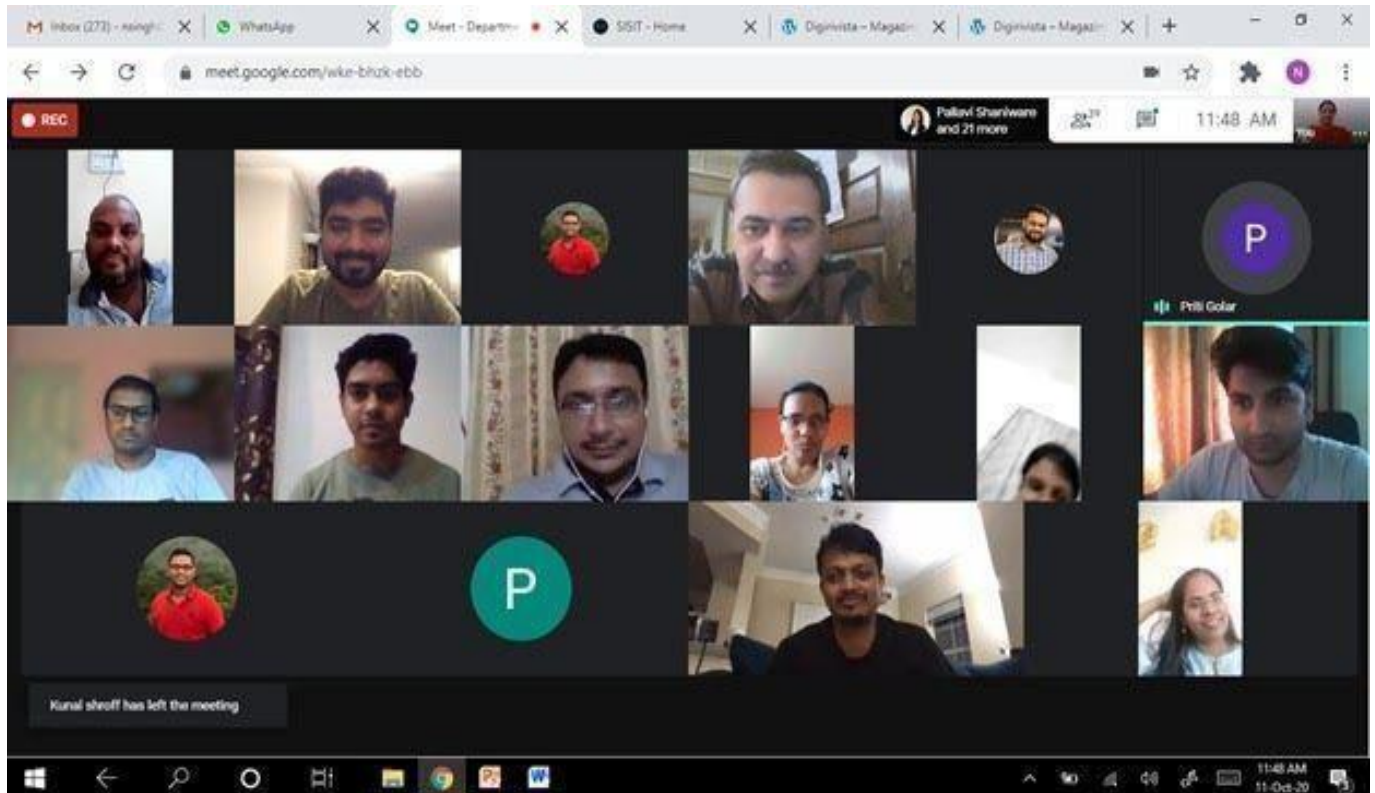
